Delivering Inclusive growth through infrastructure programming in FCAS: A Bibliography

ICAI, in its 2015 report 'Assessing Impact of the Scale-up of DFID's support to Fragile States', included a recommendation for DFID to provide guidance on targeted infrastructure components to ensure sustainable impacts in fragile states programming.

DFID commissioned the ICED facility to conduct a piece of research in response to this recommendation. This document is the desk review initiating the research.

The research terms of reference frame two key high level questions:

- *I.* What interventions (including types of infrastructure), approaches, investments and levers of influence are most effective in promoting sustainable infrastructure development in fragile and conflict affected states?
- II. How can infrastructure development be promoted in a way that:
 - a) Minimises the risk of doing harm?
 - b) Proactively supports efforts to build long-term stability?

This annotated bibliography looks at research and other relevant materials, drawing mainly on documents published following the last DFID commissioned research on this topic.^[1] It represents the first stage of the project, and will help to inform the priority issues for four country level case studies comprising the remainder of the research.
